

How to Show you horse in Canada

When you are at the Canadian Border expect the following:

- You will present your passport or passport card
- You will be asked where you are going and why – address and event (I'm going to a horse show, here's the address)
- You will be asked how long you are staying
- They will ask if you have your paperwork for your horses
- Are you bringing fresh fruit or vegetables-**Not Allowed**
- Don't bring firearms

List of what you need to have Ready:

1. You will need to get export Papers for your horse (30 day temporary export) – Your Vet can provide all the paper work.

- Current Coggins
- Health Certification-This can take up to 10 days or 7 business days to get paperwork back from USDA office in Tumwater, WA.
- Supplementary Declaration

* **Have multiple copies of each of the 3 documents.** You will need to leave one set at the Canadian entry point and another set for the US re- entry on your return.

2. Ensure you have a current Passport or Passport Card the Passport Card is like a drivers license but can be used only for ground transport between Canada and USA.

To apply for a new passport can take up to 3 weeks but you can apply for expedited service. Can apply at United States Postal Service

3. Pets – Dogs are required to have current rabies – either tag or certificate. The border will rarely ask about your dogs, however if they do, you will need to have current rabies certificate or tags for them.
